

Assessment/Evaluation Plan of the Core Subjects

Evidence of learning should be collected in an on-going continuous process using a variety of techniques. This process of collecting information and recording students' responses in order to find out what students know and can do is called assessment.

Formative Assessments

- Homework assignments in all core subjects
- Observations/translation of the language patterns students use orally and written in class activities and lesson.
- Portfolio (selected class work entry)

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES GRADE FOUR

Bible:

Students will be encouraged to collect written and pictorial spiritual based materials to make a "Spiritual Scrapbook." They will also record their own personal experiences.

Commit Bible texts and passages to memory.

Do Art to reinforce certain Bible concepts.

LANGUAGE ARTS:

Students will write and publish class book. Each student will contribute items for the book.

To fulfill one of the grade four Language Arts requirements; students will write their own stories. Part of this initial stage is choice of topic. It is said that "Nothing influences a child's attitude to writing more than the choice of topic. If the child has chosen it and if the teacher shows genuine interest in it, then there's no limit to the efforts the child will make" (Walshe, 1986, p. 9) Therefore, students will be given the opportunity to choose his or her own topic as they engage in their story writing project.

SOCIAL STUDIES:

Do research to gain knowledge of different types of buildings and their importance to human beings. Example: Libraries, Hospitals, Silos, etc.

Students will do research to find out more about Native Americans of the Northeastern USA.

SCIENCE:

Do research on different kinds of medicinal plants. Students will enhance their projects with pictures, posters, and with power point presentations.
